
# Parent information session: Home learning platforms

## Times Tables Rock Stars (TTRS)

The main game modes that we recommend are the Garage mode and the Soundcheck.



In the Garage mode, children complete questions based on the times tables that have been set by the Class Teacher.


The Soundcheck involves 25 multiplication questions. Questions can be anywhere up to 12 x 12. Children have 6 seconds to read the question, calculate and enter their answer before the game moves on to the next one. This platform is very similar to the Year 4 Multiplication Tables Check (MTC).

#### Accelerated Reader

This is the platform where children can do quizzes on the books that they have been reading. Not all books in our school library can be found on Accelerated Reader, but many can.




This platform tracks how many words the children have read in the school year and keeps a record of performance in quizzes. Teachers regularly check the website and this informs how they support children in moving through the reading scheme.



#### MyON


MyON is an online library of books linked to Accelerated Reader. It recommends books for children based on their personal ZPD. (This is a reading range of books selected for children based on their last Star Reading test, which they do in school.)



If children prefer, they can select audio for the books so that the words are read to them.



The website also collects data on the children's reading habits and transfers this over to the accelerated reader platform.



Children can use the Accelerated Reader website to take a quiz on books read on MyON.

# Spelling Shed

Spelling Shed is platform where children can play games to practise their spelling. The Stages represent school years.



When children have selected their stage, they can choose a game based on their interest. Then they can choose from a range of different difficulty levels.




The SPAG button leads to a range of different activities where children can practise Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar from their stage.



### SATs Boot Camp

This is a platform for Year 6 children to use as part of their preparation for the end of key stage assessments.



Here, children can revise a wide range of maths and literacy themes. Each one has a video tutorial, followed by questions for children to practise.
